Issues with more advanced movements can most often be traced back to balance, foot-work, connection, parallel & crossed (even & uneven) walk, forward & back ochos.

3:30 – 5:00 pm Beyond the Basics

Agustina & Claudio step it up a notch and help us with some more demanding skills: changing directions, changing dynamics, as well as enrosques & acceleration in turns.

7:00 – 8:00 pm Tango for Absolute Beginners

8:00 – 11:00 pm Love 2 Dance, Social Dancing

Before the dance, kick off the evening with a one hour Argentine Tango lesson. Agustina & Claudio will teach a special introduction to Argentine Tango covering the basics required to get around the floor.
