About Argentine Tango

Argentine Tango is more than just a dance, it is a way of moving. It is a passionate and sensual communication between two people, a way of interpreting the music, of moving together, of expressing feelings. *Tango is improvised, so there are no sequences of steps that each dancer must learn by rote.* Instead, they learn to communicate with each other throughout every step of the dance.
