Explore opportunities to change direction from "La Salida" and "La Cruzada."

1:30 – 3:00 pm Hooks and Leg Wraps

Understand the difference between Ganchos (hooks) and Enganches (wraps).

3:30 – 5:00 pm Vals – Entrances and Exits in Turns

Explore different entrances and exits for turns in Vals (Argentine Waltz).
